One of the key principles we adhere to is recognising that play is freely chosen. Play is interesting to the child. Play can involve other people or it can be a solitary activity and it may, or may not involve equipment. And, of course, play may be messy, noisy or dirty.

Loose Parts

The best way to ensure that play times are as enriching and fulfilling as possible is through the provision of 'loose parts'. These are the kinds of materials that you might typically throw away! They can be natural or man-made, and allow children to use their imaginations and work together to combine, separate, transform, transport, line up and redesign in almost endless ways. Some of our most popular items, for example, are old prams and pushchairs!

All Weather Play

Many of our children really need to be able to get outside and explore, regardless of what the weather is doing! We strongly encourage parents to provide welly boots and a waterproof top and bottoms, to keep in school. Children also need a spare change of clothes, just in case!

During hot weather, we follow the school's sun safety guidance, and ask that all parents provide sun cream, as well as a hat and sunglasses where necessary too.
